While the TSC ski season may be over, would you believe the slopes are still open? Several resorts in the US have so much snow that they are planning to stay open through the 4th of July weekend. If you're looking for a way to escape the heat, you could always go on a summer ski trip. For the rest of us, we can look forward to some great trips in the upcoming ski year.

Fall Roundup Breckenridge (Colorado)

November 22 - 27, 2011

CLASC is not supporting this trip as a club activity. If you are interested in going, let us know and we'll put you in contact with one of the other clubs.

Traditional Snowmass (Aspen, Colorado)

January 7 - 14, 2012

Laura Heiman and Teresa Savage-Tate will be leading us to this perennial club favorite. With a direct flight to Aspen airport and slope-side condos at Snowmass this is going to be a fantastic trip. See their enclosed flyer for more details.

Winter Shootout Heavenly (Lake Tahoe)

February 11 - 18, 2012

Come join the TSC as we ski the scenic slopes of Heavenly on the shore of Lake Tahoe. We'll be flying to Reno and staying in 2 bed / 2 bath condos next to the gondola and within walking distance of the restaurants and casinos. There will also be optional day trips to ski Northstar and Kirkwood.

Final Showdown Sun Valley (Idaho)

March 10 - 17, 2012

What better way to spend Spring Break than on the slopes of Sun Valley. We'll be flying to Boise and staying in 2 bed / 2 bath condos. Lift tickets will even be

interchangeable for non-skiing activities such as the spa, snowmobiling, dining, etc.

Summer Expedition Galapagos Island Tour

10 days in August 2012

Gayle Brown will be leading us on an adventurous tour of this bucket list destination. The trip includes 7 days of hiking, biking, boating, snorkeling, kayaking, and wildlife excursions around the islands. Air, lodging, activities, all meals but two, and most tips are included. 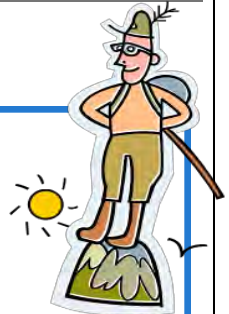

Snowmass boasts 91 downhill trails on over 3100 acres with 21 lifts including a new 8-passenger gondola from the mountain village to Elk Camp. With over 4400 feet of vertical, Snowmass has the most in the US.

Enjoy a variety of terrain from smooth corduroy groomers to wide open bowls and gladed runs to steeps and deeps.

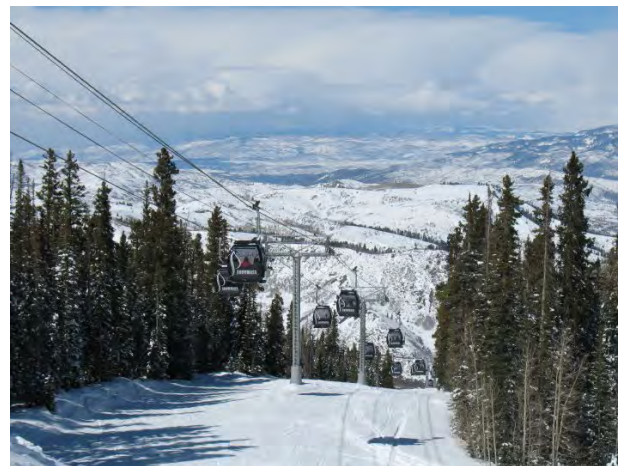

Please read this CLASC Trip and Activity Waiver Information and sign below.

A. I understand that I do not hold a reserved place on any trip until the required trip reservation deposit of fifty dollars (\$50) or the first scheduled trip payment has been paid to the Clear Lake Area Ski Club, Inc. (CLASC). Further scheduled trip payments that are delinquent in excess of ten (10) days are grounds for removal of the participant from the trip, and that in such cases cancellation penalties will apply, as described in Section B below.

B. I understand that if I cancel, or if I fail to meet the required payment schedule and am removed from the trip after a trip payment is made, I will incur a twenty-five dollar (\$25) per person cancellation fee and forfeit other payments in accordance with the cancellation schedule that has been established for the particular trip. Payments or fees may be refundable or partially refundable subject to the following conditions: If I can be replaced from the trip waiting list or by a replacement I find; If the Clear Lake Area Ski Club, Inc. (CLASC) is able to recover payments or fees from the tour operator, resort, airline, ground transportation, lodging or other agencies through which the trip has been arranged.

C. I hereby appoint the Clear Lake Area Ski Club, Inc. (CLASC), its officers, trip leaders and activity coordinators as my agent to perform all acts and to enter into any and all contracts as may be deemed desirable in connection with any CLASC trip or other activity. I understand that CLASC acts only as coordinator and accepts no responsibility for the services of any person, tour operator, resort, airline, ground transportation, lodging, or any organization whatsoever rendering any of the services or accommodations being offered on any trip or activity. Trip and other activity fees are based upon current tariffs and are subject to change without notice. CLASC accepts no responsibility in whole or in part for any delays, delayed departure or arrival, missed airline or other carrier connections, loss, damage, or injury to person or property, mechanical defect or failure of any nature howsoever caused, or for any substitution of hotels or of carrier, with or without notice, or for any additional expenses occasioned thereby. 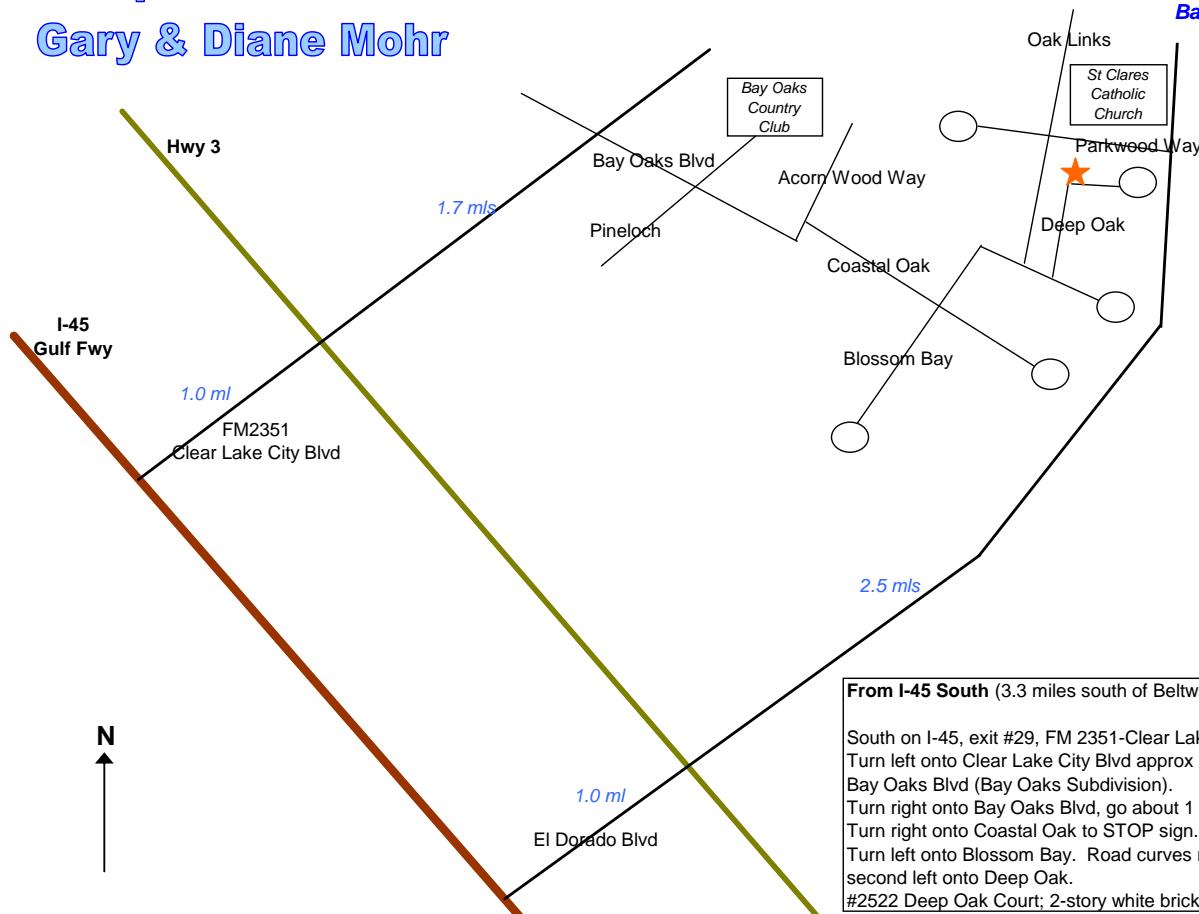

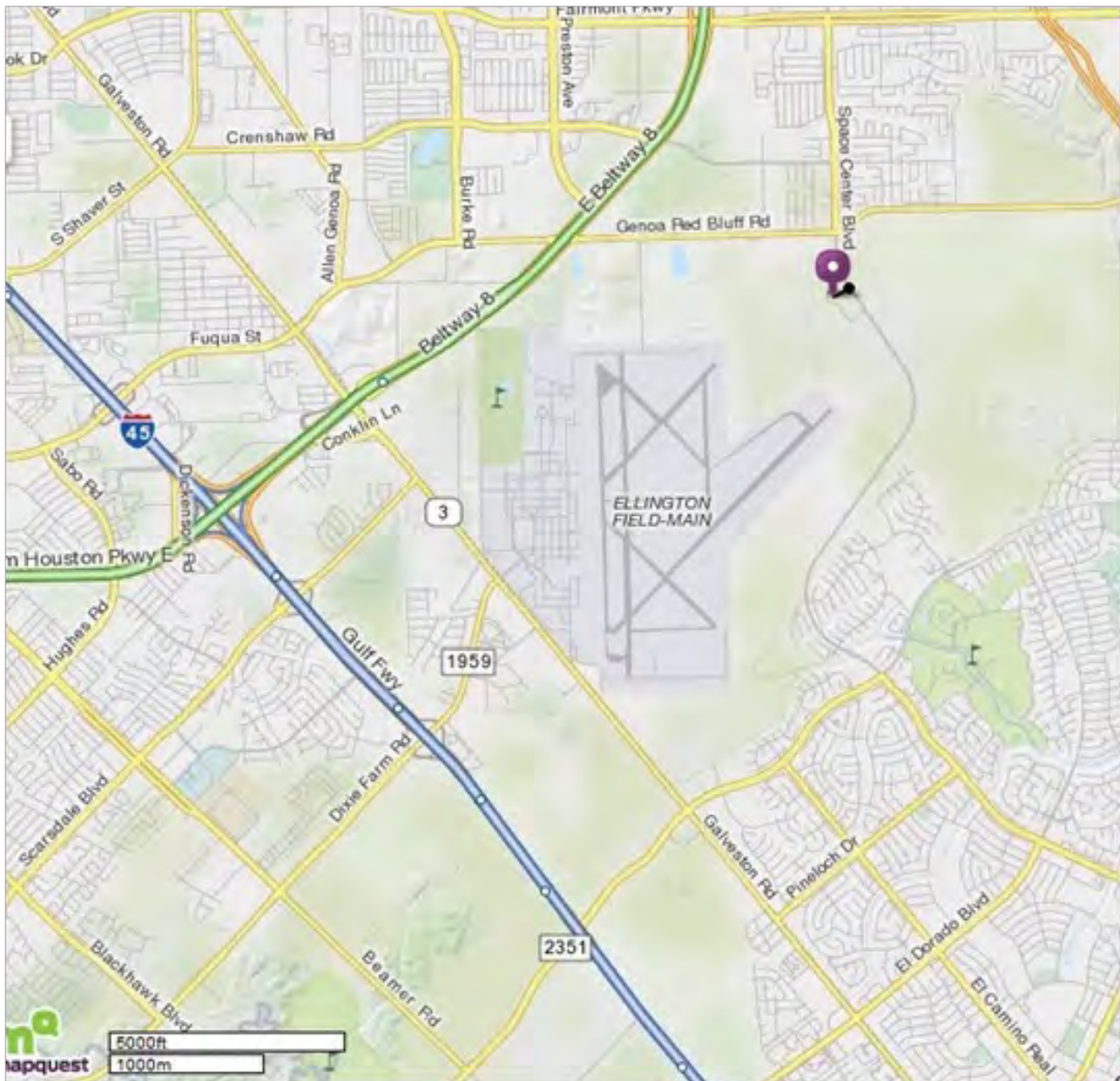

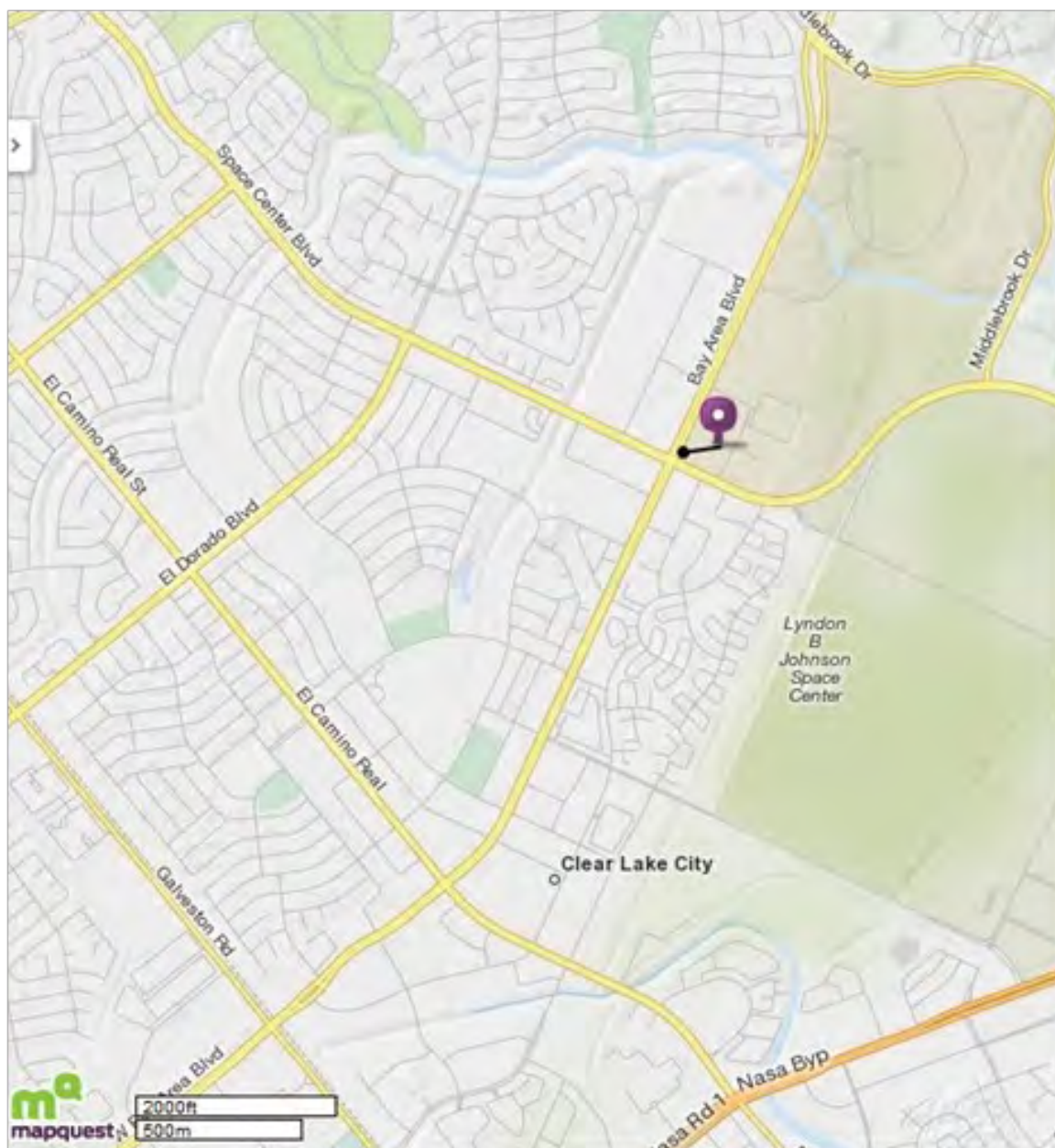
