### Trip Tracks

Hi everybody,

I just returned from the TSC trip to Snowmass where 37 of us had a great time on the slopes. Our club won 2nd place in the club races, Gayle Brown won a bronze medal overall in the women's individual races, and a several people won NASTAR medals. Congratulations to Gayle, the medal winners, and all those who raced.

We've still got two more great chances for you to ski with the club this year:

#### TSC Winter Shootout Heavenly (Lake Tahoe), February 11 - 18, 2012

Jerry Funderburg and I are taking a group to Lake Tahoe and the skiing paradise of Heavenly. We're flying directly to Reno and staying in the Forest Suites 2 bed / 2 bath condos right by the gondola. The condos are within walking distance of the restaurants and casinos as well. There are also optional day trips to ski at Northstar (which shares the same lift ticket with Heavenly) and Kirkwood. We just had a cancellation and have room for 1 person (male or female) on this trip, so contact us if you are interested. We can also add more rooms if additional people would like to go on this trip.

#### TSC Final Showdown Sun Valley (Idaho), March 10 - 17, 2012

Missy Adams is leading a group of CLASC travelers to the scenic slopes of Sun Valley for Spring Break. We'll be staying in 2 bed / 2 bath condos in Sun Valley Village. The resort even lets everybody use lift tickets towards non-skiing activities such as the spa, snowmobiling, and dining. This trip is a ground package only, all participants must arrange their own air to/from Boise airport. We especially need a solo male traveler to help fill one condo and then we'll be starting a waiting list.

#### TSC Summer Expedition Galapagos Island Tour, August 8 - 17, 2012

Gayle Brown and Andrea Lovelace will lead a group, 16 so far, on an epic adventure of these world famous islands. We'll spend a week hiking, biking, boating, snorkeling, sea kayaking, and taking wildlife excursions around the islands. Air within Ecuador, lodging, activities, most meals, and most tips are included. The dead line for optional pre and post trip extensions to Machu Picchu and the Amazon has expired. However, sign ups can still be accepted for those extensions subject to availability. Remember, it takes a long time to get certain wilderness permits.

We have just one opening left on Heavenly and Sun Valley so sign up soon. Signups for Galapagos are also subject to availability. If you are interested in any of those trips, please contact the trip leaders to get on the wait list. If somebody has to drop off the trip any time before it starts, which does happen occasionally, then we will use the wait list to try and fill that spot. Also if enough people get on the wait list, then we can try and add additional lodging.

It's time to start thinking about trips for 2013. Next month we'll be surveying the members to see where you would like to go next year. Your participation will be important towards selecting future trips.

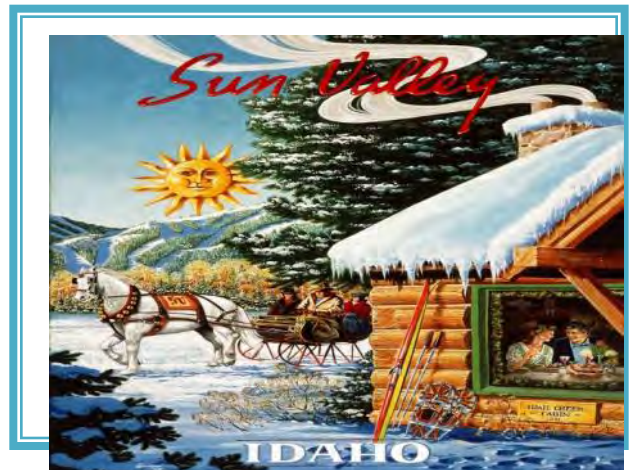
## TSC Final Showdown March 10-17, 2012

The resort has two mountains – not connected but very near each other. Dollar Mountain is smaller – good for novice skiers and snowboarders and Bald Mountain boasts that it was/is the “playground” of Hollywood stars and Olympian Picabo Street; there are runs for all skier levels. ### CLEAR LAKE AREA SKI CLUB OFFICER CANDIDATE APPLICATION FORM

The Clear Lake Area Ski Club (CLASC) is a non-profit volunteer organization managed by a governing Board of Directors (BOD). CLASC is looking for some special people to serve as officers and help this club continue its great traditions and begin some new ones. WE NEED YOU! You can do this! We know many of you have served before, but the club needs you again! This is your opportunity to contribute to the members and gain a lot in return (closer friendships, pride in a job well done, etc.).

Eligibility. All candidates for elected or appointed office must be CLASC members in good standing, as defined by the club By-Laws.

The following are brief descriptions of each elected BOD officer's responsibilities:

1. President: The Chief Executive Officer of the club. Performs the general supervision, direction, and control of the business and officers of the club.
2. Vice President (VP) Trips: Has the overall responsibility for all ski and other trips run by the club.
3. VP Administration & Membership (A & M): Records the official administrative business, makes logistic arrangements for general membership meetings and maintains membership records for the club.
4. VP Activities and Programs (A & P): Is responsible for coordinating club activities other than trips and for organizing programs for general memberships meetings.
5. VP Marketing and Merchandising (M & M): Is responsible for publicity and public relations functions of the club, marketing to increase club membership and coordinating the sale of CLASC merchandise.
6. Treasurer: Is responsible for conducting the financial and accounting functions of the club.

There are some other voting officer positions that are appointed by the elected BOD. These are:

1. Texas Ski Council Representative: Serves as official liaison between the CLASC and the Texas Ski Council (TSC). Normally the immediate past president or another member selected by the elected BOD.
2. Members-at-Large: Two past officers selected by the elected BOD who serve as parliamentarians to the Board.
3. Assistant VP Trips: Assists the VP Trips in a manner designated by the VP Trips or the BOD.
4. Assistant VP Activities & Programs: Assists the VP Activities & Programs in a manner designated by the VP A & P or the BOD.

There are some additional non voting officer positions that are also appointed by the elected BOD. These are:

1. Lifeline Editor: Is responsible for the layout, editing of content and publication of the CLASC Lifeline newsletter.
2. Webmaster: Is responsible for managing the CLASC Web site and e-mail account.

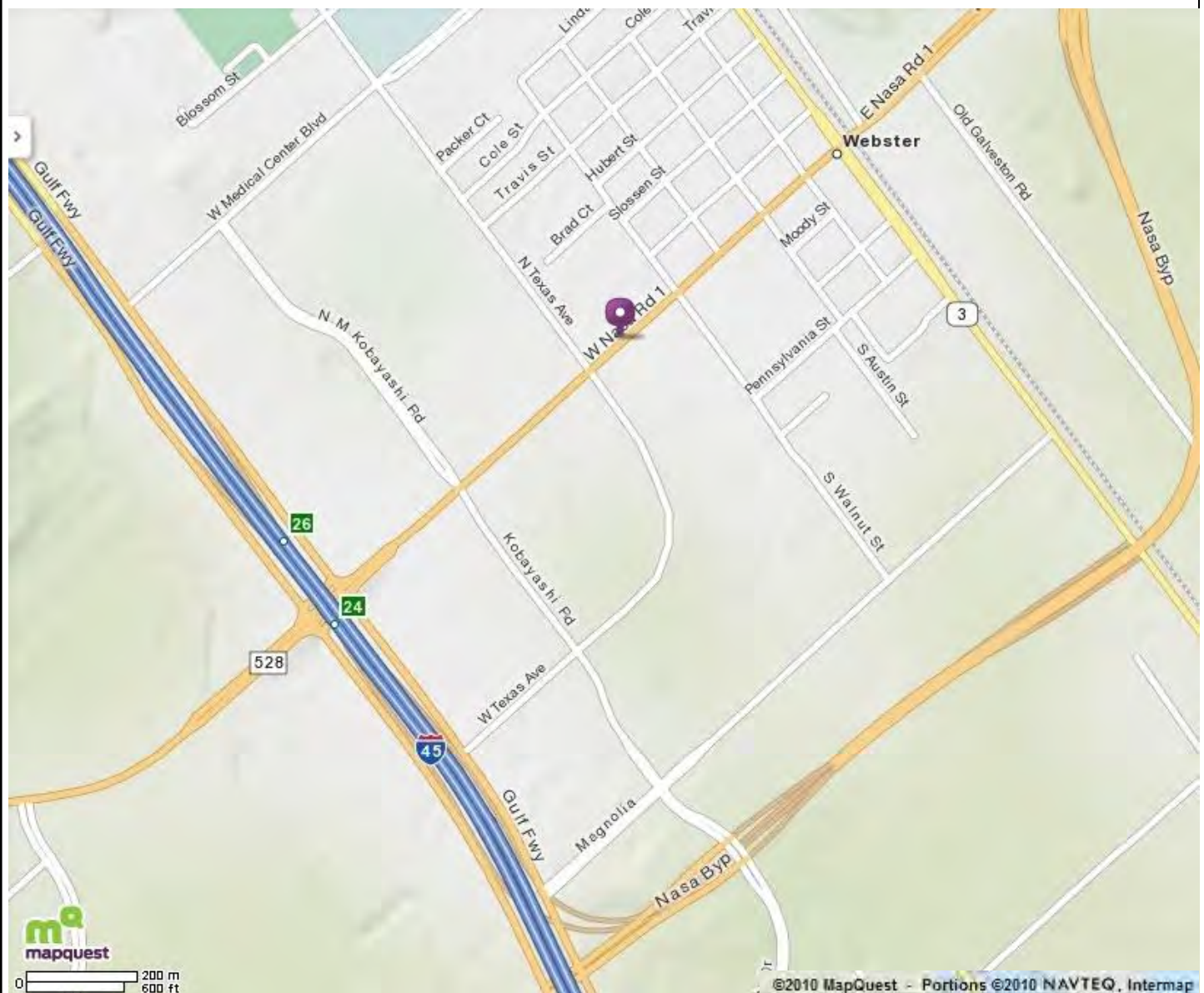

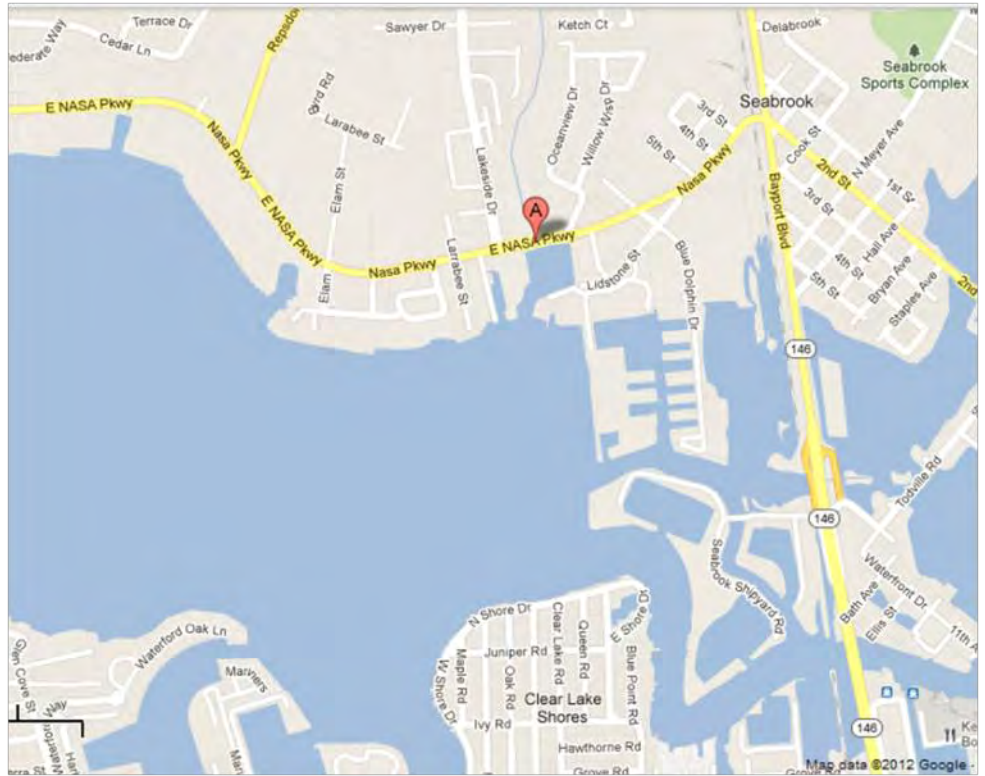

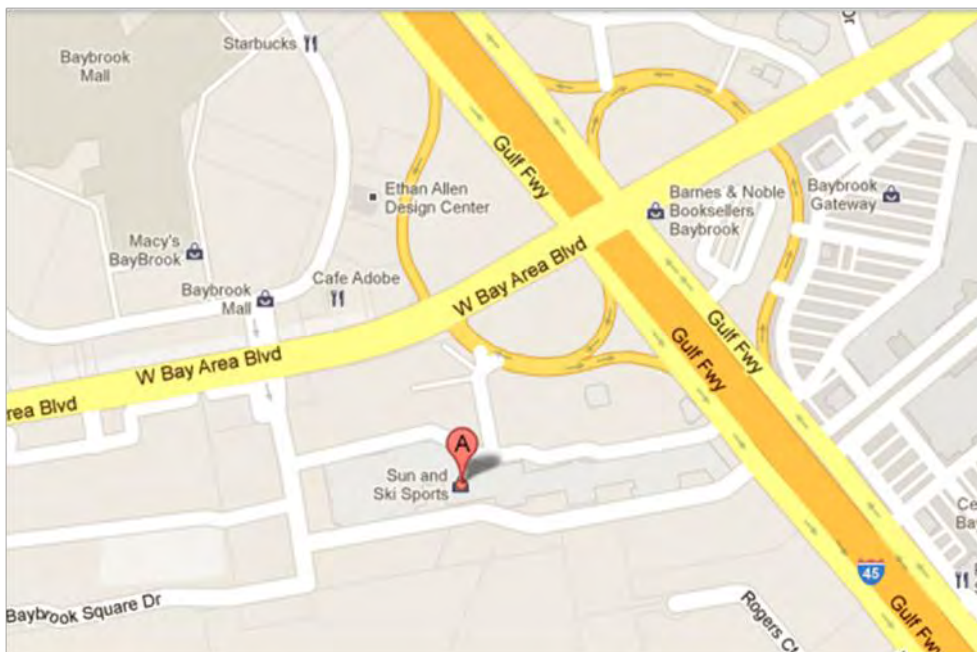
